Yet, school leaders often do not receive professional development in critical instructional leadership skills. Reach has designed a unique, research-based practice series and tools for leaders who want to hone their evaluation and supervision skills, specifically in the area of observation-based instructional conferences. In the Instructional Conferencing Practice Series, leaders will participate in monthly meetings, developing a shared understanding of the phases of instructional conferencing, and will assess their conferencing videos in relation to indicators for effectiveness.
